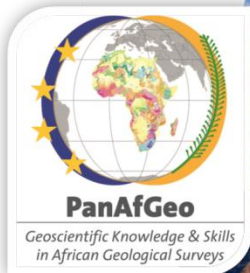


”Environmental management of mines” Lobatse, Botswana, 6-17 November.
