During the month of November AMGC organized a training course on Data Integration and Mineral Targeting, for a participant from Eritrea. The Centre also organized a clay-ceramic art workshop for students from Tanganyika international school in Dar es Salaam.

AMGC Director General participated in the Africa Forum on Mining, organized by AUC in Accra, Ghana from 13th to 15th

November 2019. 114 participants out of approximately 200 confirmed from governments, regional organizations, continental institutions and other stakeholders attended and discussed in panels issues of strategic importance for the mining sector in Africa and for Africa. The role of the AMGC is recognized as one of the pillars for implementation of the African Mining Vision (AMV). Key participants underscored the need for a collaboration by signing a MoU between AMGC and the African Natural Resources Centre, which affiliated to African Development Bank (AfDB) based in Abidjan, Ivory Coast.

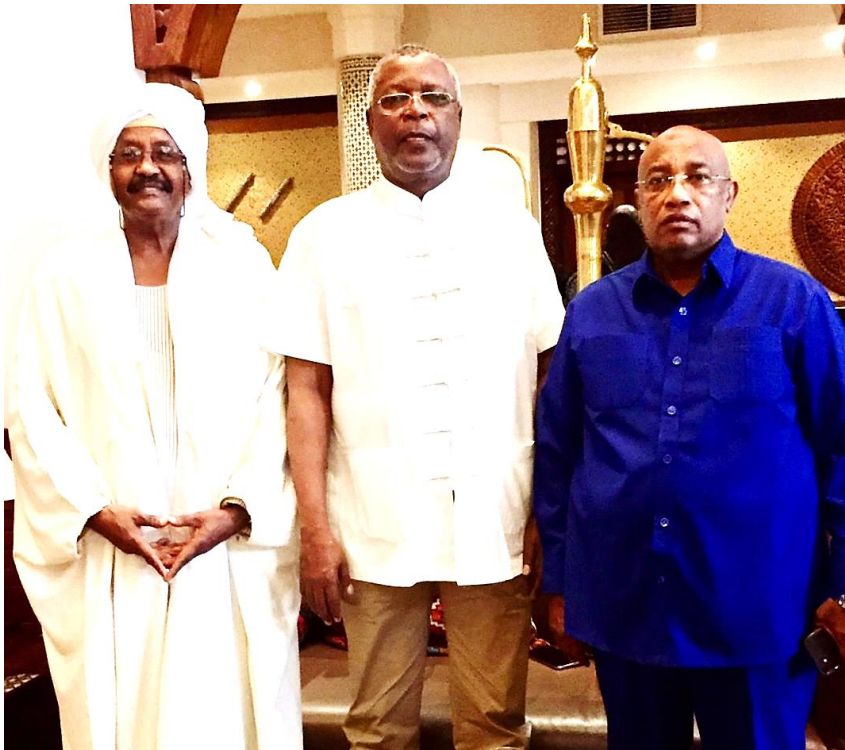


Finnish Counsellor, H.E. Kari Leppänen Visit

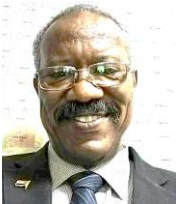
