





# What is PanAfGeo+?

PanAfGeo+ (2025–2029) is the European Union's flagship programme supporting Africa-Europe partnerships on geological sciences. It strengthens geoscientific knowledge, services and cooperation to support sustainable development, responsible resource management and informed decision-making along the CRM value chain.

# Why PanAfGeo+?

Reliable geoscientific information supports:

- sustainable management of natural resources (e.g., mineral resources assessment, geoheritage and its conservation),
- climate resilience and environmental protection,
- risk mitigation (e.g., geohazards and environmental management of mines),
- responsible and transparent investment along the CRM value chain.

PanAfGeo+ strengthens African geoscientific institutions so geoscience can better support policy and development planning.



# Three integrated components



## Partnerships

Strengthening Africa–Europe cooperation and institutional dialogue in geosciences.



## Capacity Building

Training, skills development and knowledge exchange for African geoscientists and geological surveys.



## Invest

Dialogue and matchmaking to support responsible, sustainable investment all along the CRM value chain through improved geoscientific, economics and ESG knowledge.
